



'The King is not well,' the Queen said to them. 'You two must do the King's work.'




So they did the King's work. Shrek was not good at it!

'No one understands us,' he said. 'The good fairy tale characters have the best of everything. Is that OK?'


'No!' they all shouted.

'Arthur, you are the King's heir,' said Shrek.


'Come to Far Far Away.'

Arthur crashed the ship. The ship had water in it. They went onto the land.




They saw an old man. He was Merlin the magician!

'No, stop!' Shrek shouted. 'He's not the heir. I am, OK?'


Arthur looked at him. 'But you said ...'
