The book said the only way to break the ring's spell was to return it to its owner—an ancient princess.





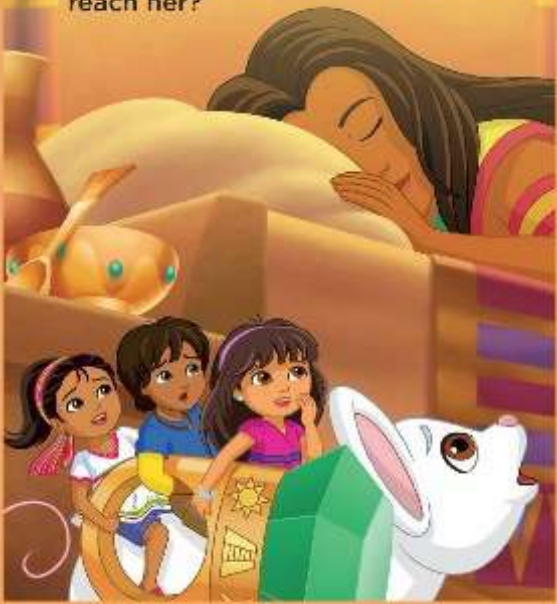


We looked carefully in the spot where Pablo found the ring and discovered a magic door to the princess's kingdom. Dora and I had to shrink to fit through it!

I knew that ancient people used seesaws to lift heavy stones and build pyramids. We could make a seesaw with the princess's cup and spoon!



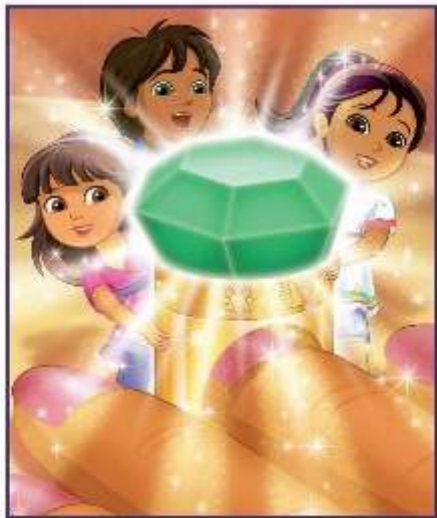
We stood on one end of the spoon and our mouse friend jumped on the other.
