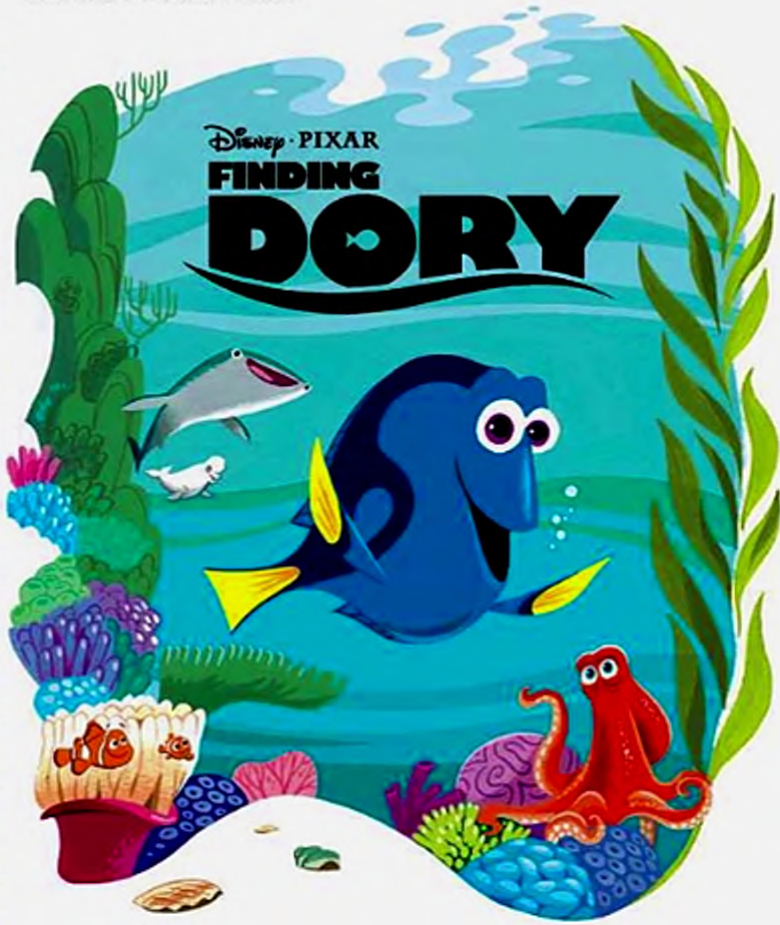

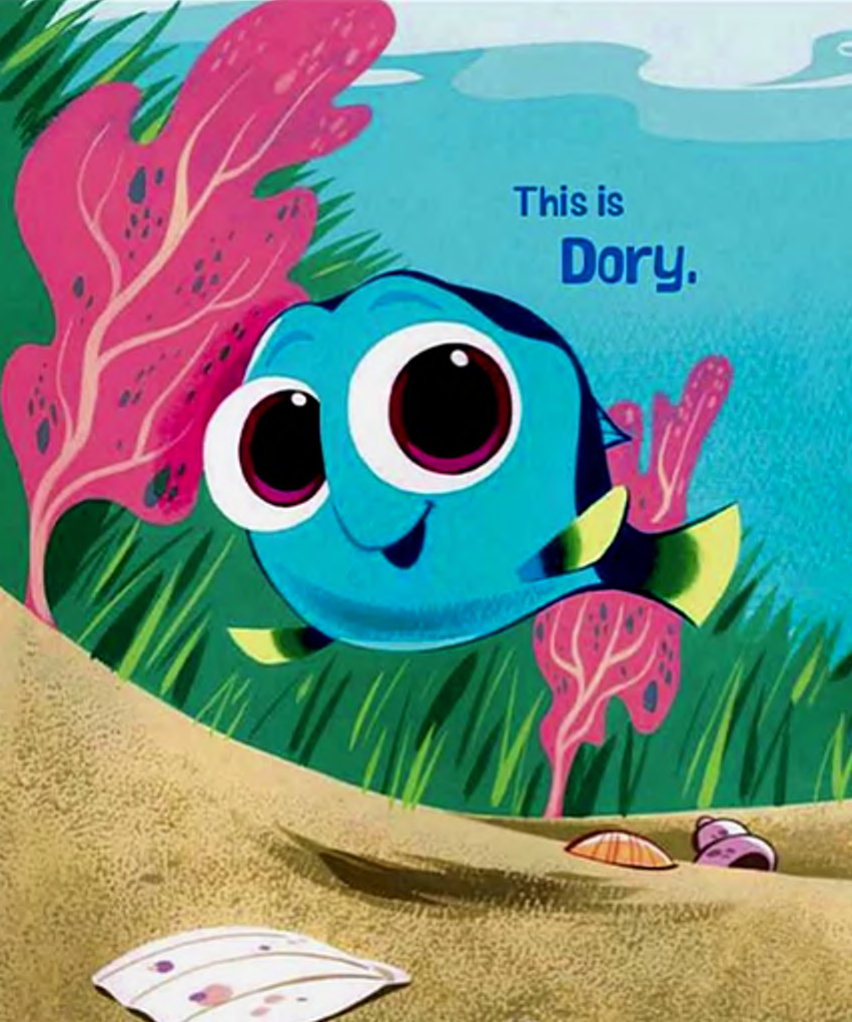



find her parents.

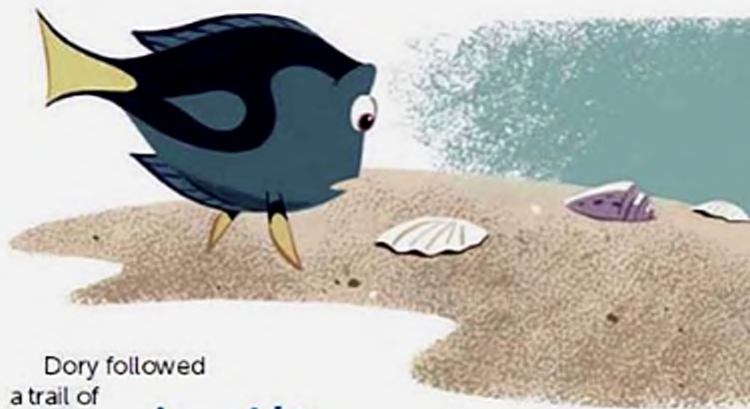


She followed the directions and ended up

all alone again.**

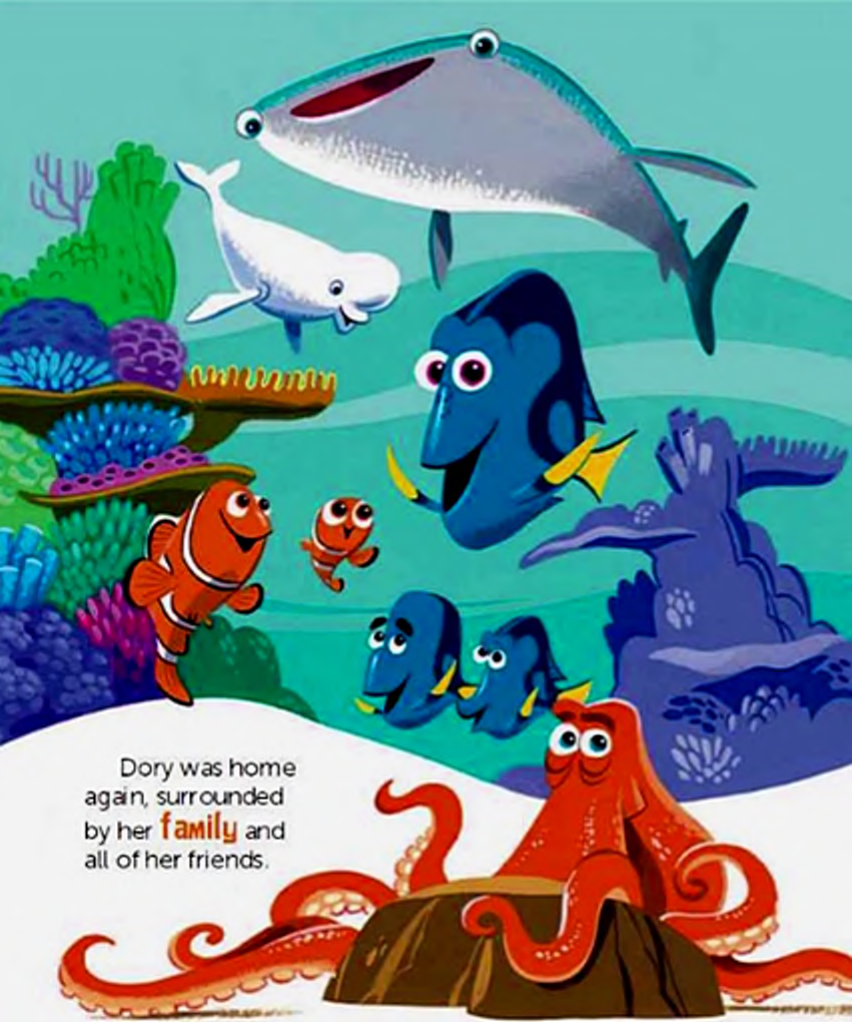
Dory worried that she'd never find her way home. Then she spotted another shell, and another.
