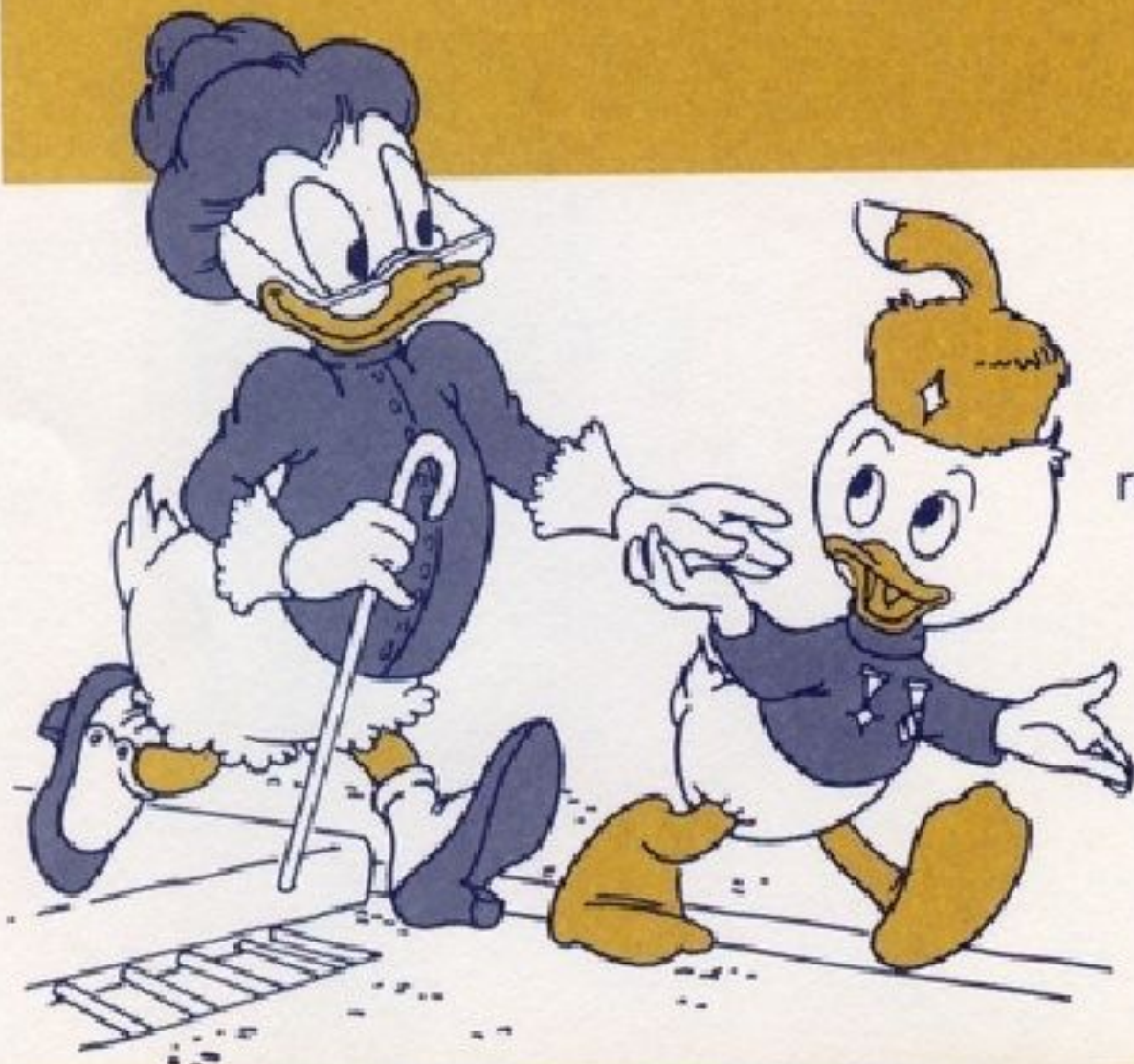

Stands Michael with his teddy bear.



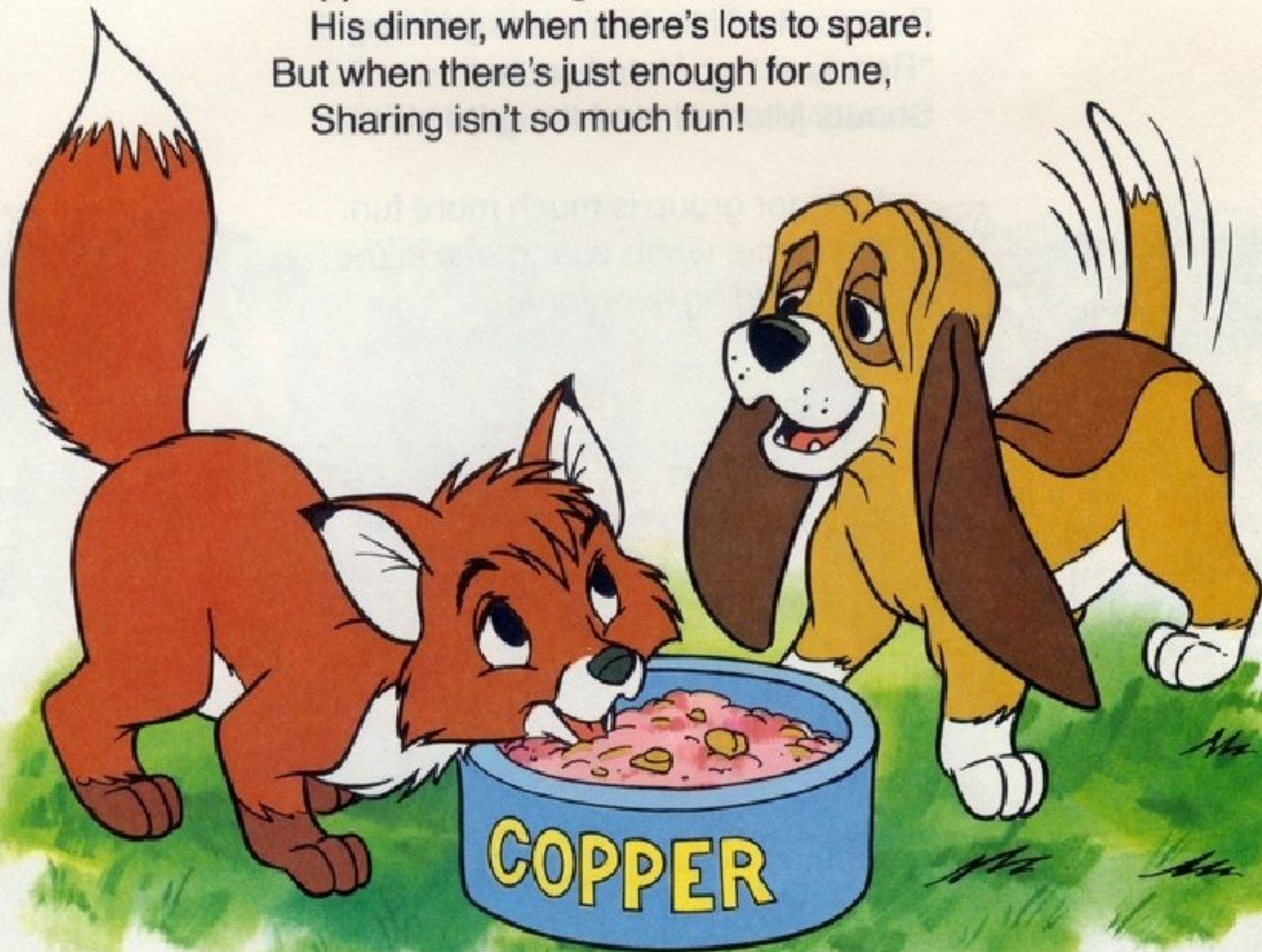


“Michael, come, we’re just beginning,”

You won't resemble Madam Mim!

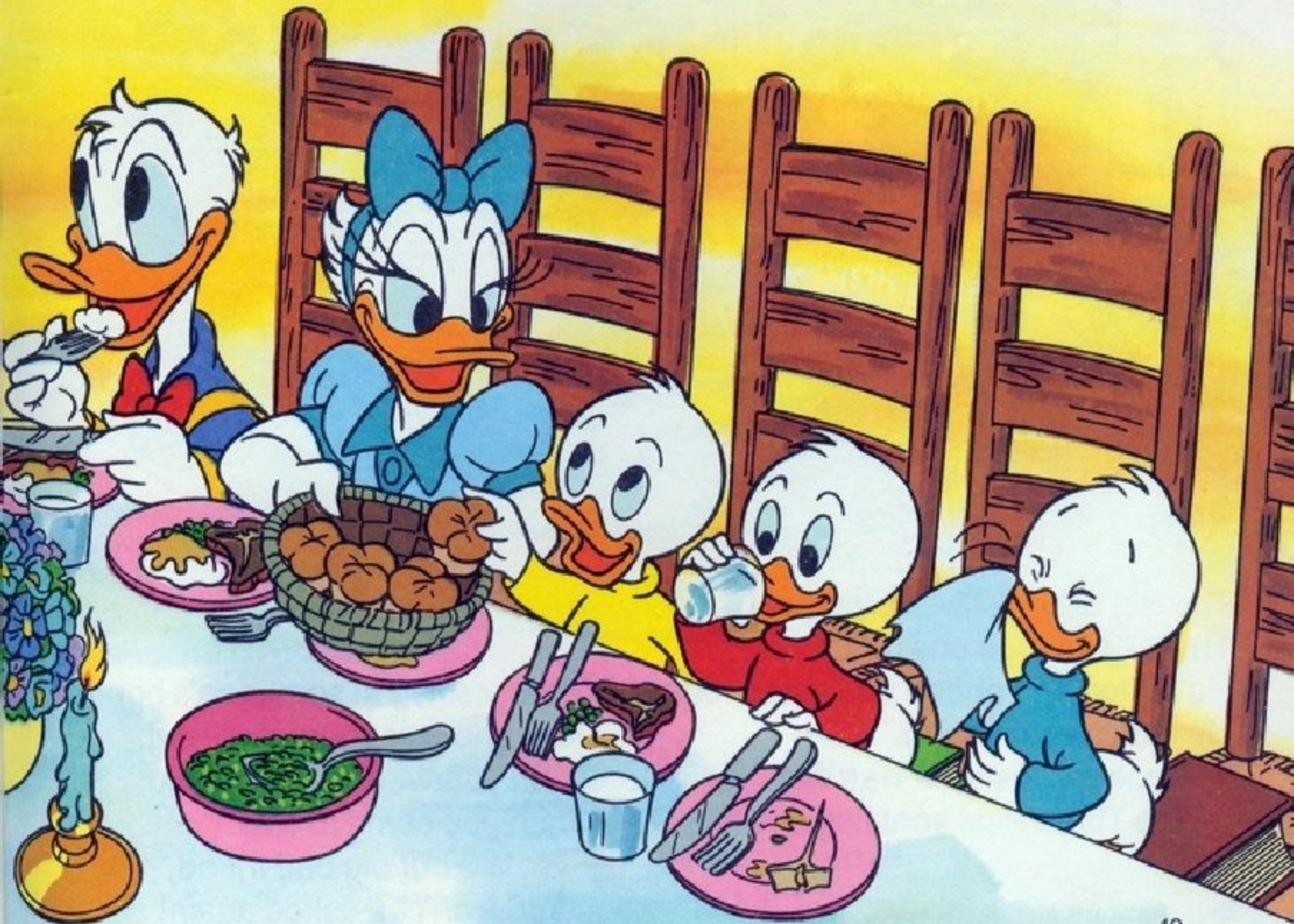
When Mickey's friends come by to dinner

"You did!"

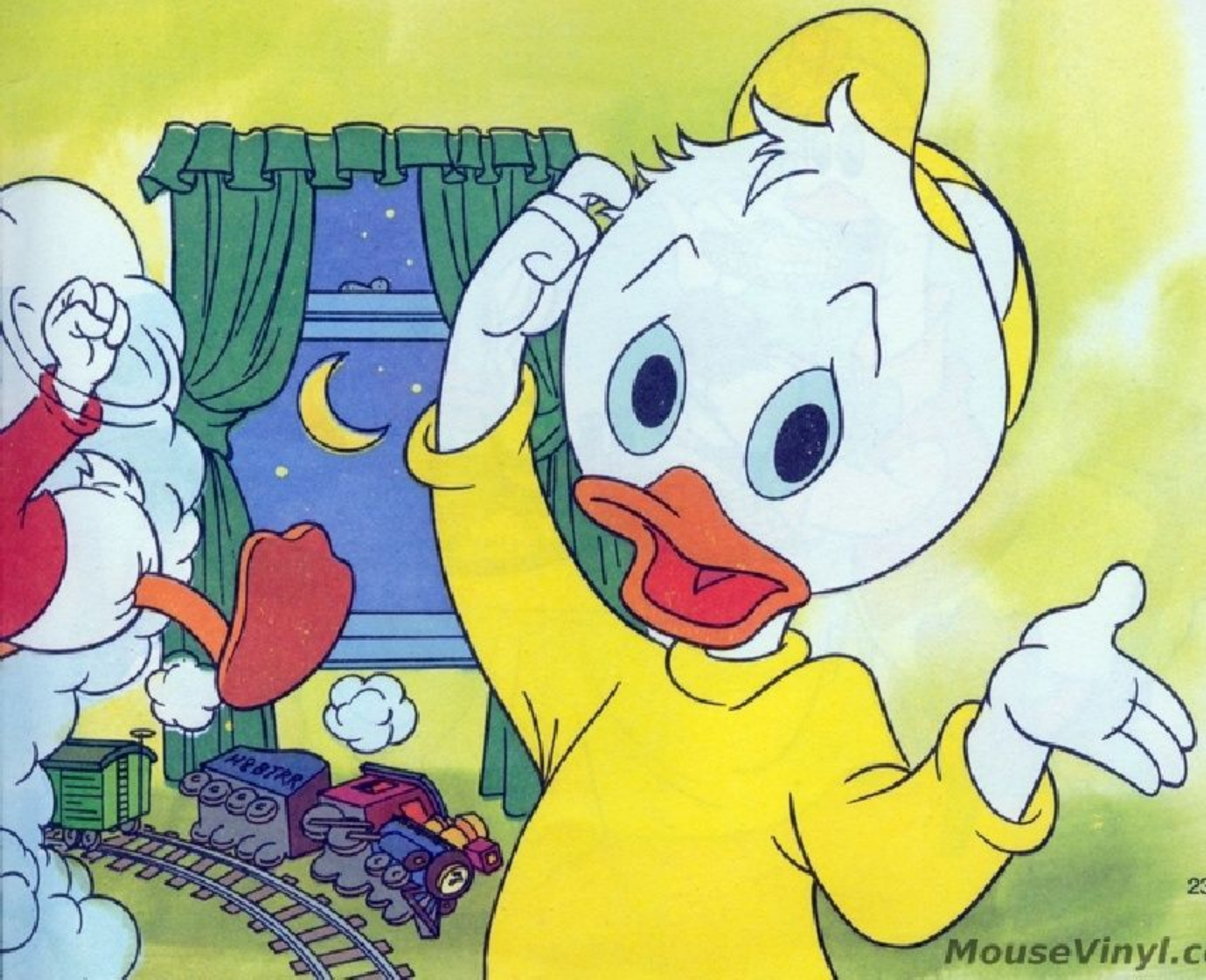
"I didn't!"

"You couldn't!"

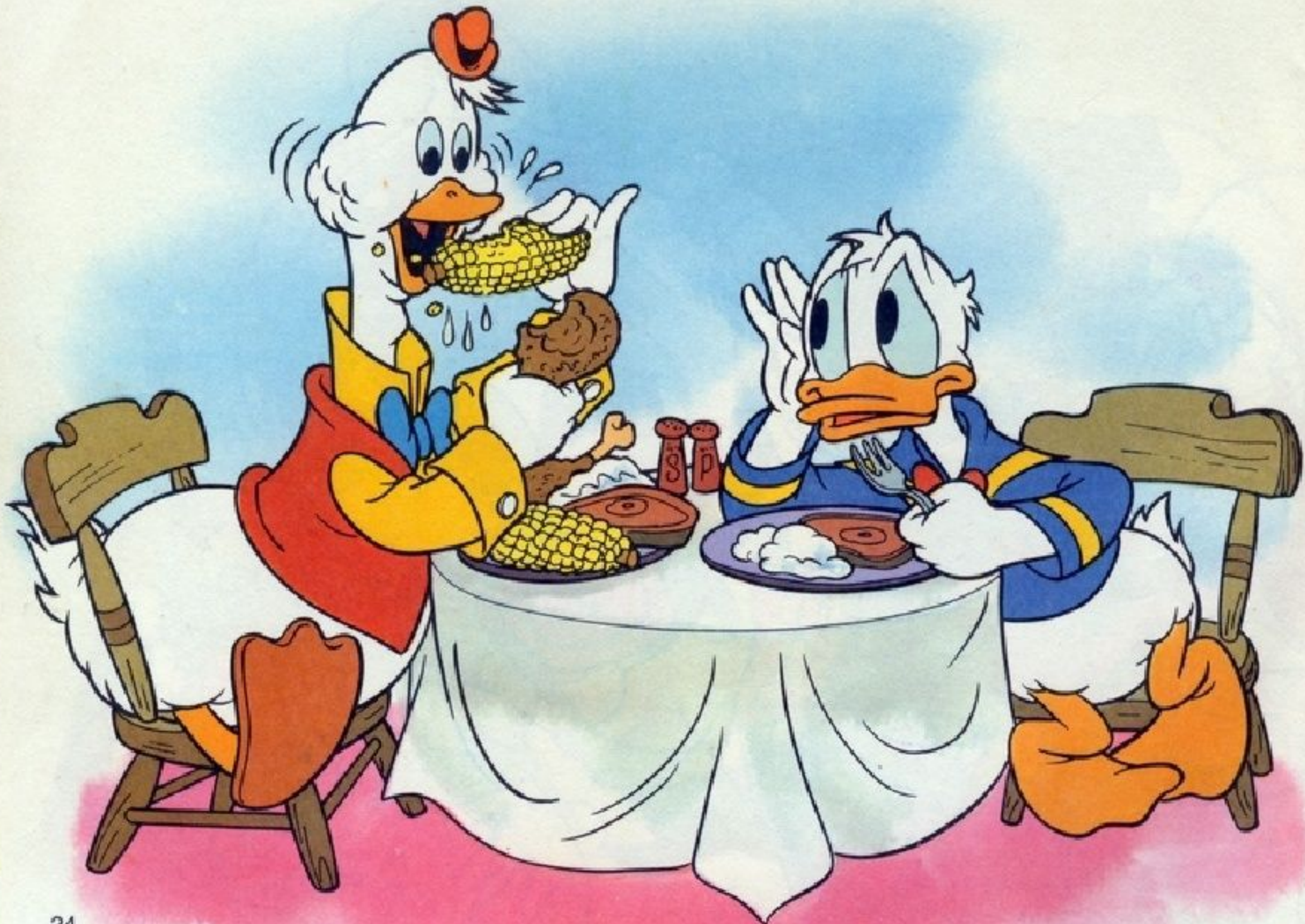




All three are quite certain that
