So La Diva waved her magic wand, and took away all the music in Opera Land.

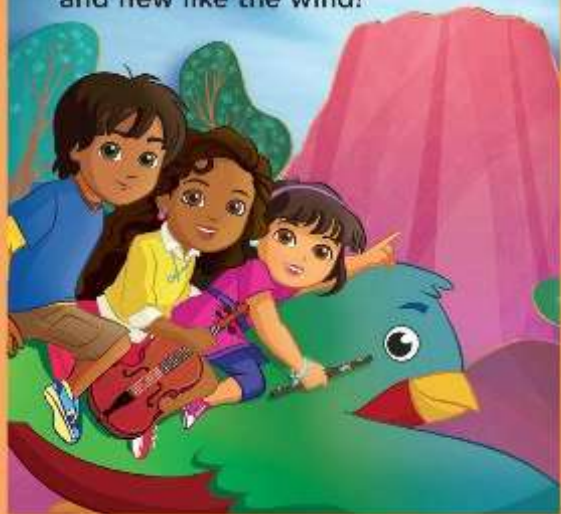
No one could play their instruments anymore!



Can you imagine a world without music? *iQué triste!* We had to get the music back for my grandma's party AND bring music back to Opera Land!



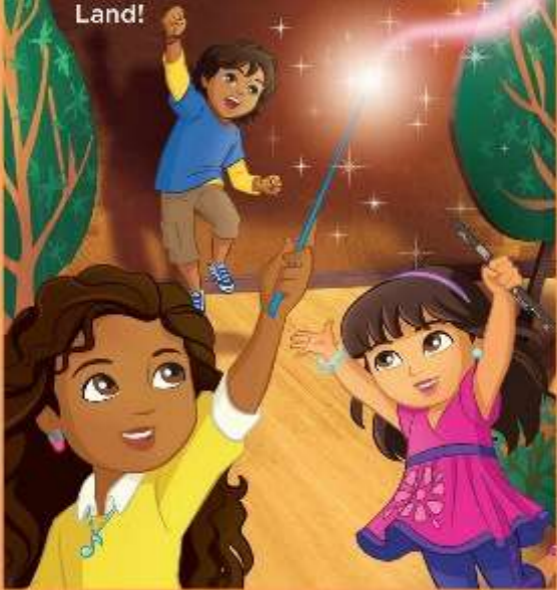
La Diva lived on a mountaintop far away. So Dora used her magic charm bracelet to make a bird appear. We climbed on its back and flew like the wind!
