




One winter morning, Strawberry Shortcake

Custard's night caps.




"Come on, Apple Dumplin'," Strawberry said to her little sister.

"There's lots of fresh snow in Cookie Corners."


"And I want to have a snowball fight!" said Huckleberry Pie.

the hill together!" Strawberry said happily.






After sledding for a long time, Strawberry Shortcake and her friends decided to build snowmen in Cookie Corners. Soon they had made a whole family of snowmen!

MARSHMALLOW SNOWMEN

For each snowman, you will need:
3 large marshmallows
toothpicks
red thin licorice rope
black thin licorice rope



1. Stick the toothpicks into each end of one marshmallow. This marshmallow will be the snowman's middle.
2. Stick the other two marshmallows on the top and bottom.
3. Use small pieces of the black licorice to make eyes, a nose, and a mouth (stick them on with a toothpick).
4. Use a three-inch section of the red licorice to tie around the snowman's neck and make a scarf!

PRETTY PAPER SNOWFLAKES

You will need:
typing or construction paper
scissors
glitter
pom-poms

1. Fold a sheet of paper in half.
2. Cut out a half-circle along the crease. Then fold it in half.
3. Unfold it and decorate it with glitter and pom-pom stickers.
4. Cut out shapes and designs on all edges.

YUMMY HOT CHOCOLATE

Make sure there is a grown-up in the kitchen to help you make this yummy hot chocolate!

You will need:

2 tablespoons cream
2 tablespoons cocoa powder
2 tablespoons sugar
2 cups milk
whipped cream, marshmallows,
chocolate shavings (optional)



1. In a small pot over low heat, mix the cream, cocoa powder, and sugar until they form a thick paste.
2. Slowly pour in the milk. Stir constantly until all ingredients are combined and the milk is very warm.
3. Carefully pour the hot chocolate into two cups.
4. Add whipped cream, marshmallows, or chocolate shavings to make it extra yummy! Makes 2 servings—one for you and one for a berry good friend!
