"Hey!" yells Ian as Olivia turns off a faucet. "Save water!" Olivia cries.




Dad finds his paper.

Olivia tells Ian that if he keeps the light off, he can knock on the wall for her if he gets scared. Ian knocked all night.




The next morning they are very tired.

"No. That uses up batteries," says Olivia.


"I need to think."
