Set 1: Books 1-6 8 pages per book The alphabet, letter sounds, and beginning sight words are introduced.


Sets 2-4: Books 7-24 8 pages per book Consonants frequently found in words, short-vowel sounds, and additional sight words are featured.

 The blending of consonant and vowel sounds is presented. This skill enables children to read hundreds of words independently.


Sets 7-12: **Books** 37-72 16 pages per book



and I can run from you. I can!"





If your child is ready:


- · Have your child read the sentences that have "My Words" in them.
